Storage and distribution:

Product should be stored and transported in accordance with good warehouse practices. Transport facilities should be allowed to foodstuffs transport. It is necessary to protect product against freezing. Frozen product cannot be dedicated for sale. It is not allowed to store product near heat supply or in places with direct exposure to the sun. Best storage temperature is $5 - 20 \text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$. Maximum storage temperature cannot be higher than 35°C . Recommended storage temperature in refrigerators is $5 - 9 \text{ }^{\circ}\text{C}$ Product easily absorbs foreign smells and undergoes degradation. It is important to keep it away from paints, phenol derivatives, organic solvents, disinfectants or other compounds

with intense odour. Do not use pallets impregnated chemically.
It is necessary to apply proper product rotation: take product from the warehouse according to FEFO rules. The shorter storage time, the lower possibility to reduce product quality caused by environmental condition. Maximum permitted storage height - 2 and 1/2 pallets (NR-PET), 3 pallets (glass containers), 1 pallet (can). Between pallets there must be a paper spacer.
Refrigerate after opening and consume within 2 days.

Intended use: The product is intended for direct consumption by persons over 3 years of age (children aged 0 to 3 are covered by a special nutritional program).
Not recommended for consumption by diabetics.
